



## Onsite Designated Supervisor Award (ODS)

The **IOSH Onsite Designated Supervisors Award** is the UK's first practical Pool Plant Operators Course, whereby a minimum of 50% of the content of the course is the delivery of practical skills within the Pool and Plant Rooms and includes:

This Award is also an accredited program of the **UK Pool Water Treatment Advisory Group**

Course Content includes:

### Practical Elements

- Backwashing
- Filter Valve controls
- Chemical Handling
- Automatic Dosing Systems
- Emergency Procedures
- Pool Water Testing

*The practical skills are developed depending on the pool plant rooms of training and are bespoke for all facilities*

### Theory Element

- Pollution and hygiene
- Management, regulation and training
- Pool water chemistry
- Testing and controlling pool water chemistry
- Health and Safety

**Assessment:** Exam Paper in the form of a multiple choice question paper, and practical assessment which is undertaken by performing various skills tests within the Pool Plant Room.

**Course Duration:** 2 Day (can be dependent on the size of the technical plant, review of organisations pool plant normal operating procedures will determine if any reduction in time is possible).
