

POOL & SPA WATER TESTING

Intended Audience

This course covers the basics of Water Testing in all environments whether that be Pools, Spa's Hydrotherapy or Aquariums.

Course Description

This course provides learners with the skills to perform water tests accurately, understanding the importance of methodology and its effect on test outcomes.

Leaners will also have a basic understanding of the effects of free chlorine on chloramines, interpreting the results and acting on Free chlorine residuals, and ensure results are correctly documented.

A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Pool and Spa Water Testing Certification.

POOL PLANT SUPERVISOR

Intended Audience

This course is intended to introduce students to the fundamental workings of a plant room. Suitable for students with no formal training in pool plant spaces.

Course Description

This course provides learners with the skills to undertake a number of day to day duties within a pool plant room.

Practical Skills included in the course cover topics such as strainer basket management, filter backwashing, chemical management and pool water testing.

Delivered Onsite Only, this course is specific to each plant room training is delivered from, and ideal for inhouse training.

A learner must be able to demonstrate skills in the pool plant area. A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Pool Plant Supervisor Certification.

You will also learn how to maintain water which is safe and pleasant to swim in, how to correctly test pool water and understand how to restore it to ideal conditions.



This certificate is valid for three years, and you will need to revalidate at this point.

Course Program

A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Swimming Pool Technical Operator Certification.

- Controlling chlorine and chemical levels
- Managing water supplies and water treatment
- Testing for pollution and parasite infection
- Maintaining pipes, circulation and filtration
- Promoting health and safety

- Disinfecting water
- Balancing pH and alkalinity
- Diagnosing and testing the water
- Making savings on heating, ventilation and energy
- Maintaining swimming pool hygiene



HYDROTHERAPY POOL TECHNICAL OPERATOR

Intended Audience

This course is intended for any persons who have responsibility for the Operation, Maintenance and/or Management of a Hydrotherapy Pool Facility.

Course Description

This course covers everything you need to effectively maintain a Hydrotherapy pool, and conforms to PWTAG Guidelines, and the Aquatic Therapy Association of Chartered Physiotherapists (ATACP) 2021 Guidance on Aquatic Physiotherapy.



You will learn how to maintain water which is safe and pleasant to swim in, how to correctly test pool water and understand how to restore it to ideal conditions.

This certificate is valid for three years, and you will need to revalidate at this point.

Course Program

A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Hydrotherapy Pool Technical Operator Certification.

- Pollution and Hygiene
- Management Health and Safety, Regulations and Training

- O Pool Design, Hydraulics and Circulation.
- Promoting health and safety

HOT TUB TECHNICAL OPERATOR

Intended Audience

This course is intended for any persons who have responsibility for the Operation, Maintenance and/or Management of a Hot Tub Facility such as Holiday Park Operator.

Course Description

It covers everything you need to effectively maintain a Hot Tub in any setting.

You will learn about the design standards, and operational requirements of hot tubs, including disinfection standards, chemical safety and microbiological control.

This certificate is valid for three years, and you will need to revalidate at this point.



Course Program

A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Hot Tub Technical Operator Certification.

- Microbiological Standards

- Maintaining Hot Tub hygiene

SPA POOL TECHNICAL OPERATOR

Intended Audience

This course is intended for any persons who have responsibility for the Operation, Maintenance and/or Management of a Spa Pool Facility.

Course Description

It covers everything you need to effectively maintain a Spa Pool to current industry guidelines, and in compliance with the UK Legionnaires Disease, Code of Practice L8, and HSPC Legionellosis Control in Ireland.

You will learn how to safely operate a Spa Pool, to maintain efficient chemical levels, and maintain a clean and hygienic pool to the highest standard possible.

This certificate is valid for three years, and you will need to revalidate at this point.



Course Program

A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Spa Pool Technical Operator Certification.

Intended Audience


This course is intended for any persons who have responsibility for the management of Aquatic Animal Enclosures.

You will learn how to safely operate water quality standards, to ensure safe standards

for all aquatic mammals, and to undertake day to day supervision of technical plant in the management of said facilities.



This certificate is valid for three years, and you will need to revalidate at this point.



A pass rate of 70% must be obtained to gain the Aquatic Animal Pool Technical Operator.
